DR. DEBORAH LIPSTADT, the Dorot Professor of Modern Jewish and Holocaust Studies at Emory University, is a prolific author and respected contributor to major academic journals devoted to Holocaust research.



Dr. Lipstadt authored Denying the Holocaust: The Growing Assault on Truth and Memory (Free Press/Macmillan, 1993), the first comprehensive history of the Holocaust denial movement. Her History on Trial: My Day in Court with David Irving (Ecco/HarperCollins, 2005), chronicles Dr. Lipstadt's legal battle with the Holocaust denier which resulted in a resounding victory for Lipstadt and a defeat for the prejudice, extremism, and distortion of history that defined Irving's work.
